Alumni Scholarship

The Alumni Scholarship is a \$500 award that is based on academic achievement, character and citizenship along with financial need. The recipient must be enrolled in a program of formal training at a recognized university, college or school when receiving the money. The program need not be a four year one.

Walter & Anna Barkell Memorial Scholarship

One award of \$1,000 will be made from the Walter and Anna Barkell Memorial Scholarship Fund. The selection will be made on the basis of scholarship, citizenship, character and financial need to graduates of this high school who have been accepted for advanced training by a college, university, or other approved institution of learning. Must be enrolled in a program of formal training at a recognized university, college or school when receiving the money. The program need not be a 4-year one.

Joseph & Mary Bilgen Pope Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship has been established in the memory of Joseph and Mary Bilgen-Pope. Mary Bilgen-Pope was a graduate from the Lake Linden-Hubbell High School in 1948.

The recipient of the Joseph and Mary Bilgen-Pope Scholarship will be selected by a committee made up of teachers, administration and a Board of Education member.

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded on the basis of achievement as related to the effort demonstrated by the student in the following areas: academic, character, civic, leadership and reasonable expectation of completing the course of study selected. This scholarship will be divided into two payments, one half at the start of the Fall semester/term and one half at the start of the second semester/term after proof of all guidelines have been met at the completion of the first semester/term. The institution must be approved by the agency authorized for accreditation of the particular type of technical or professional field.

- Criteria:
1. Is enrolled in a Post-High School Educational Program
Examples: College, University, Vocational School, Trade School, Apprenticeships, etc.
 2. High School grade point average of 2.5 or better
 3. Maintains a college grade point of 2.5 or better

Failure on the part of the awardee to meet the above requirements will result in the remainder of that award reverting to the Joseph and Mary Bilgen-Pope Scholarship Fund. An interruption due to illness or other personal problems could be a basis for waiver of the requirement at the direction of the Lake Linden-Hubbell selection committee listed above.

Megan Brogan Memorial Scholarship for the Arts

The Megan Brogan Memorial Scholarship for the Arts was established by the family of Megan Brogan in the year 2000. Megan was a 1999 graduate of the Lake Linden-Hubbell Schools.

The Megan Brogan Scholarship is a \$1,000 award. Preference will be given to students planning to enroll in the Arts, Music or Communications.

John J. Burke, MD Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship shall be awarded to a graduating senior. The award will be for \$300 to be renewed annually for four years of enrollment, not to exceed a total award of \$1,200 and based on the awardee meeting the following criteria:

1. Has completed high school with an academic GPA of 3.0 or better.
2. Is enrolled in a 4-year program in a medical related field at an accredited college or university
3. Maintains a college GPA of 3.0 or better for each year preceding renewal of the award.
4. Whose enrollment and attendance in the university program is for four consecutive years in an approved medical related field. (An interruption due to illness or other personal problem could be a basis for waiver of this requirement at the discretion of the LL-H Board of Education.

Failure on the part of the awardee to meet the above requirements will result in the remainder of that award reverting to the John J. Burke, MD Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Irving Clouthier Memorial Scholarship

The Irving Clouthier Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to one or more applicants to receive one to four year scholarships. Consideration will be given to need, character and grade point average in awarding this scholarship. A college GPA of 2.5 or better must be maintained in order to be eligible for subsequent payments (after the initial installment).

William B. Gertz Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded each year to a graduating senior. The award is for \$350 to be renewed annually for four years of enrollment at Michigan Technological University, not to exceed a total of \$1,400 and is based on the awardee meeting the following criteria:

1. Has an academic GPA of 3.0 or better
2. Maintains a college GPA of 2.75 or better for each year preceding the renewal of the award.
3. Whose enrollment and attendance in the University program is for four consecutive years (An interruption due to illness of other personal problem could be a basis for waiver of this requirement at the discretion of the LL-H Board of Education.)

Failure on the part of the awardee to meet the above requirements will result in the remainder of that award reverting to the William B. Gertz Scholarship Fund.

Agnes Godin Scholarship

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded based upon academic achievement. The recipient must be worthy in terms of character and citizenship, must be enrolled in a program of formal training at a recognized university, college or school. It does not need to be a four year program.

Margaret Jones Scholarship

An award will be made to one or more applicants to receive one to four year scholarships from the Margaret Jones Scholarship Fund. The recipient must be accepted in a four-year undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university and have attended Lake Linden-Hubbell High School for a minimum of three years. The selection will be made on the basis of financial need, good attendance, and the applicant's potential for becoming an outstanding student, athlete or otherwise contributing in an outstanding way to the academic life. A college GPA of 2.5 or better must be maintained in order to be eligible for subsequent payments (after the initial installment).

Agnes Prince Scholarship

A scholarship in memory of Agnes Prince, a former teacher in our schools, is awarded each year. This award is \$250 per year for four years to a student entering a baccalaureate degree program. Applicants must have an academic GPA of 2.75 or better and must maintain that average each year in their degree program to be eligible for each year's stipend. A student failing to maintain that average would lose further rights to receive any of the balance of the funds. The total amount awarded to any successful applicant will not exceed \$1,000. The initial award will also be based on the applicant's character, chance of success in the chosen program and financial need.

Ruppe-Bosch Scholarship

This will be awarded each year to a graduating senior. The award will be for \$300 to be renewed annually for a maximum of four years of enrollment at an accredited college or university not to exceed a total of \$1,200 and based on the awardee meeting the following criteria:

1. Has a high school academic GPA of 3.0 or better
2. Maintains a college GPA of 2.75 or better for each year preceding the renewal of the award.
3. Whose enrollment and attendance at the college or university is consecutive (An interruption due to illness or other personal problem could be a basis for waiver of this requirement at the discretion of the LL-H Board of Education.)

Failure on the part of the awardee to meet the above requirements will result in the remainder of that award reverting to the Ruppe-Bosch Scholarship Fund to be applied to the principal of the fund.

In the event of a future re-organization of the LL-H School District, student awardees of this scholarship are to continue to be residents of the LL-H District as constituted at the time of the first award (1990).
